Candidate Requirements:

Candidates must be a resident of the City of Augusta and registered to vote in Augusta.

Candidates are required to file a Clean Election Registration form at the time they file their nomination petition forms and before they accept any contributions or make any expenditures, including "in kind".

Signatures Required:

- Mayor and Chairperson for School Board are required to obtain not less than 200 signatures from any registered voters in Augusta.
- City Council and School Board At-Large are required to obtain not less than 100 signatures from any registered voters in Augusta.
- City Council and School Board by ward are required to obtain not less than 50 signatures from registered voters in Augusta, in the ward being sought.
